

University of St. Thomas (Houston, Texas) A Reintroduction

- Founded by the Basilian Fathers in 1947, we are the only Catholic university in Houston, Texas – the 4th largest city in the United States.
- 2. One of a small number of American universities qualifying as Hispanic Serving Institution and Asian-American Pacific Islander Serving Institution.
- 3. El Centro Semillero now offers two Spanish-instruction Masters degrees.
- Nearing 4,000 total students in 40+ undergraduate and 30+ graduate programs across the schools of Business, Education and Human Services, Arts & Sciences, Nursing, and Theology.
- 5. In 2019, launched the Kolbe School of Innovation that offers Associates Degrees.
- 6. Elevated from a Regional University to National University in 2022 college rankings.
- Our new strategic plan entitled "Greater Things" includes four guiding vision statements. One of these is concerted expansion of UST's global engagement.



Goals for International Collaboration

- 1. Prioritize ICUSTA partners and Catholic universities that could make strong additions to the ICUSTA family.
- 2. Expand physical and virtual modes of academic cooperation/ exchange.
- 3. Develop double degree undergraduate and graduate programs.
- 4. Infuse international mobilities with the Corporal Works of Mercy.
- 5. Increase student group exchanges with ICUSTA partner schools.
- 6. Expand infrastructure to support and mentor international students.
- 7. Streamline application and admissions processes for international students and address financial barriers.
